

What Is the Average Time for a Social Security Disability Claim?

Q: If I cannot work, how am I supposed to support myself while applying for social security disability?

A: It can take quite some time for an application for social security disability to go through the review process. Finding ways to get by in the meantime can be worrisome for some claimants. Knowing that the review process can take time, a first step is to plan ahead financially. Do not make any unnecessary purchases, especially large ones. Even if you can pay for those things now, you need to have a financial cushion should your claim take a year or two. Put any money you save by cutting discretionary spending aside to help you through the time it may take to reach a decision about your social security disability claim. Mandatory expenditures can sometimes be adjusted to allow flexibility during the waiting period. Some utility companies, for example, offer low income energy assistance programs. Refinancing a mortgage or other loan to free up funds can be an option. Some applicants are fortunate to have loved ones that can help them with financial support during the interim period. If you can no longer pay your medical bills, seek assistance. You need to continue to go to the doctor. Many charities offer assistance to pay for medications. Look into state health assistance programs. Find free clinics, if need be, for routine visits. Many medical offices will help individuals in financial need by coming up with bill payment strategies. Explain your situation and be proactive before you get in trouble. Filing for public assistance programs can also be helpful. General Assistance is a state program that can lend you money that will have to be repaid after your social security disability case has been processed. Filing for food stamps and housing assistance may be beneficial for you, if the application process takes longer than expected. If you are in financial dire straights, you might consider talking to a [social security attorney](#). You may be eligible for dire need assistance with social security. Such assistance can help expedite your claim and offer monetary aid.

Q: Is it possible to apply for social security disability benefits at an actual Social Security office?

A: You can apply for social security disability insurance online, over the phone or in person. Most people believe handling it in person is the most advantageous. Meeting with your claims representative will give you one on one communication. The claims representative will have a chance to observe you functioning with your current injury or condition, and you have a chance to introduce your case. An in person appointment gives your claim the foundation for the application review process. Call the toll free number (800) 772.1213 for Social Security and ask for an appointment to submit your application for social security disability. You will then receive a confirmation of the scheduled appointment via mail.

Q: When should you expect notification of a decision on a social security disability case?
