Patient education also takes top priority with dentists in Jackson. New parents are encouraged to bring their babies in for their first checkup at approximately six months of age, as signs of tooth decay could already be developing in unerupted teeth. Your Jackson dentist will most certainly instruct you to put your baby to bed with only water in his or her bottle, as milk or juice will continuously bathe the babys gums with sugar as the liquid sits in his or her mouth all night. Continuous exposure to sugars in this manner could trigger the development of early tooth decay.

You can also receive cosmetic and restorative services from your dentist in Jackson. Broken, chipped or cracked teeth put a real damper on your smile, so why not ask your Jackson dentist to restore it to its former luster? Porcelain crowns, or caps, fit over an entire tooth surface to provide support to weak teeth and protective cover for damaged or severely decayed teeth; they are durable enough to last for at least ten years.

Dental bridges do exactly what their name suggests: they bridge gaps between teeth. They also prevent remaining teeth from shifting position. For cavities, dentists in Jackson offer tooth colored composite fillings, which are bonded directly to your teeth to maintain a seamless smile. No more ugly metal fillings to distract from your natural beauty!

Porcelain inlays and onlays are used in cases in which substantial structure has been lost to damage or decay; they are bonded to teeth to restore damaged tooth structure and prevent further decay. Dentists in Jackson also provide dentures made from either plastic or porcelain to patients who have lost entire teeth to the effects of age, decay or extraction.
